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**INTRODUCTION**

**ACTIVITIES**

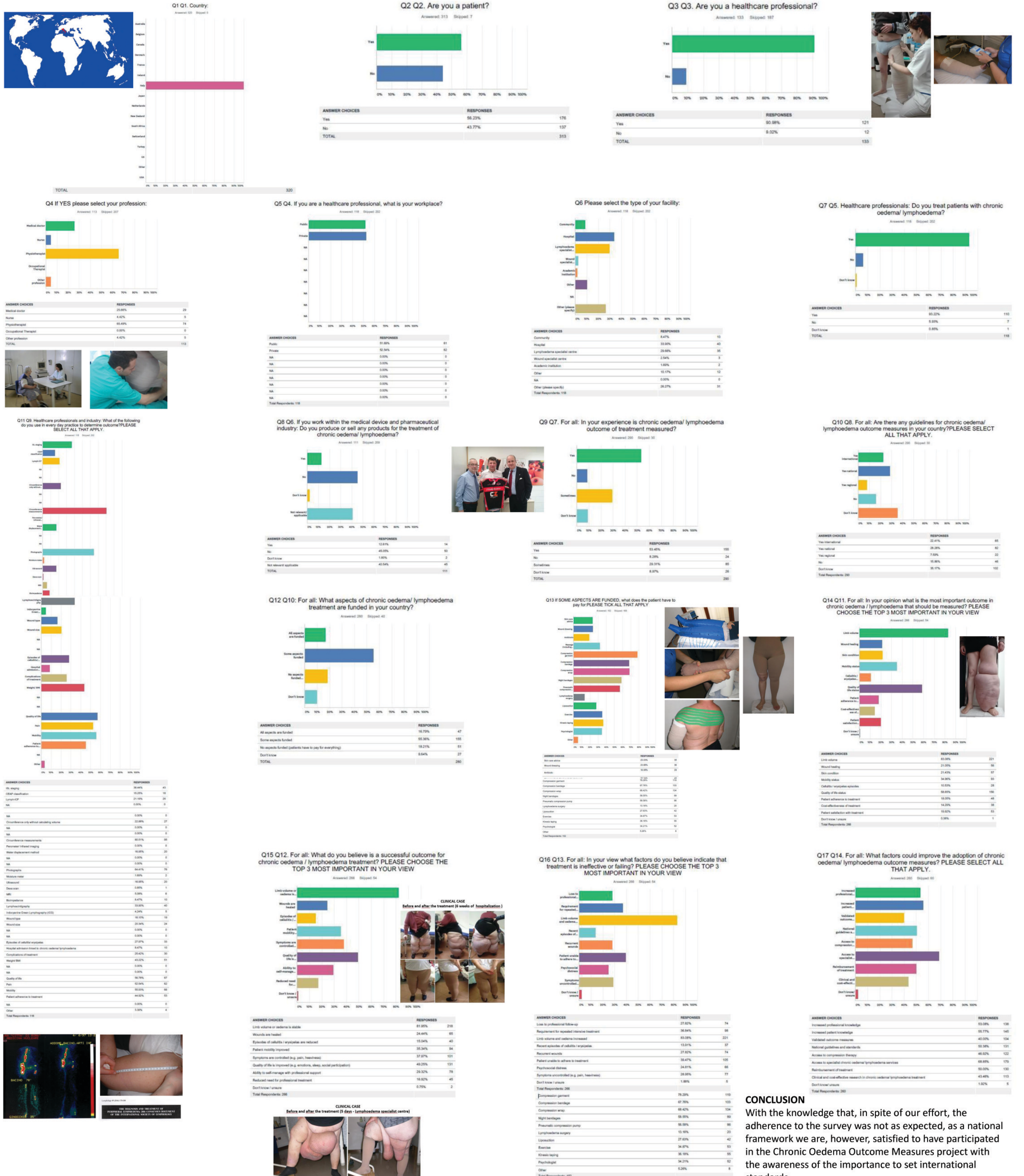
Our study site was activated to carry out the survey, also using the Italian Lymphoedema Framework website for wider dissemination, and with the results of the survey worked on the design of the poster.
